Summary of Golf & Greens Committee meeting

July 15, 2024

<u>**Rhett**</u> reported that we're on budget as far as Annuals & Playcards are concerned. Seventy-nine percent (79%) of rounds YTD are resident rounds, however rounds for the entire year are predicted to be lower than last year, mainly due to weather issues. This spurred a discussion about whether or not tournaments (inside and outside tournaments) are adversely affecting revenue. There is an ongoing analysis of this.

There was also a discussion about keeping The Turn open longer hours (10-6, for example).

Cost of Sales revenue was down due to the computer issues in May.

<u>Ryan</u> advised that core aerification on greens, tees, and greens surrounds will take place on MTW next week. They're not addressing fairways at this point.

Old Business

- There was a Chelsea double-booking issue in June that is being taken care of.
- Cigars will be available on the beverage cart this month.
- There was discussion about having the Par 3 tournament at a later start time, but it doesn't appear that will happen
- There was a discussion about naming the last 3 holes on the North Course. It was voted down.

New Business

- The Golfer's handbook is being updated by an ad hoc committee.
- There was a brief discussion about adding A/C to the restrooms, but it was determined that if we can just get everyone to leave the fans alone (they keep getting unplugged), the temp won't be that bad.
- Golf course maintenance requests should be addressed by Rhett
- Since the new Bocce courts will have restrooms, there was discussion about having restrooms built at the same time between South 9 and North 1. Unfortunately, this would have to be approved by the City of Denton so no timeline for the golf course ones yet.
