RRWGA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

May 20, 2024 RR Clubhouse

Sue Galinski, President, called the meeting to order at 9:01 AM

Secretary's Report

April minutes were accepted with one correction for the March notes which was added. The corrected version will be posted to the WGA website.

Treasurer's Report (Peggy Puckett)

There was a balance in the general account of \$7527.39. This has been reconciled as of 4/30/24 with the UMB bank statement. No withdrawals or expenses in April. Deposits included dues from new members and wind jacket orders.

There was a balance in the tournament account of \$16,778.40. Account has been reconciled with the UMB bank statement of 4/30/24. Deposits included Hoof & Heels sponsor checks, member/member entries and lunch payments. Withdrawals included payouts for the member/member tournament.

The 2023 IRS tax return was completed. Jayne Gornik and Paula DiFonzo audited the books for the first quarter of 2024. The Treasurer's report was accepted.

Vice President's Report (Candy Mikulik)

Candy reported that the eclectic tournament was a success with 69 players and the tournament came in under budget. Jayne Gornik will send out a summary of the winners. Candy reviewed the remaining tournaments for 2024. All are on track. The next tournament is Match Play on June 17 and 18. The pink tournament will not be held this year. Instead, there will be a replacement – more information will be coming.

Director of Golf (Craig Pullen)

Craig was unable to attend.

Rules (Gabie Bull)

Gabie reviewed the requirement of players on the tee box before the first player hits. There is not a requirement according to the PGA of New Jersey. All agreed on the following – 4 players should be on the tee box before hitting the first shot on the 1st and 10th tee box. For all other tee boxes, 2 players should be there before hitting.

Each player is only permitted 14 clubs in their bag. Other bags should be removed. You cannot borrow another player's club at any time.

Tuesday Play Day (Staci Brown)

Everything is going well, nothing to report.

Handicap Chair (Jamey Siefert, Jackie Williams)

Jamey reported that the RR Handicap Committee is still being formed. Various leagues have differing expectations for this committee. Discussions continue. WGA playdays now post in GHIN as a competition round.

Membership (Donna Phillips)

We have 143 members with one new since the last report. This includes 17 new members this year, and 56 of our members are dual members with the WLN.

Special Committee Reports

Old Business

Club Championship, Robson Cup and Silver Cup Qualifications

Slight changes to tournament guidelines which will be updated and posted to the WGA website. All voting members voted and the updates were accepted.

- 1. Players will choose one of the 3 tournaments to participate in about two weeks prior to the tournament. All 3 tournaments will be on the same days/times as in the past. Players will select one of the following to participate in Silver Tournament, Robson Cup or Club Championship. That decision will enroll her in the tournament she chooses and exclude her from the other two tournaments. Vote was 7 yes, 2 no and one abstain.
- 2. RRWGA Club Championship Requirements participants must have played 5 rounds on either WGA playdays or tournaments during the calendar year. A minimum of 12 rounds must be played on the Wildhorse Golf Courses and entered into the handicap system during the calendar year. (GHIN index) RRWGA Robson Cup Requirements participants must play a minimum of 5 rounds on either WGA playdays or tournaments during the calendar year. A minimum of 12 rounds must be played on the Wildhorse Golf Courses and entered in the handicap system during the calendar year (GHIN index). Votes for item 2 were all yes.

3. RRWGA Silver Cup requirements – Participant must be 70 years old on the scheduled tournament day. A minimum of 5 rounds played from the silver tees on either WGA playdays or tournaments during the calendar year. A minimum of 12 rounds played on the Wildhorse Golf Courses and entered in the handicap system during the calendar year. Vote was 8 yes, with 2 abstaining.
